Are you facing eviction?

Our **homeless prevention** may be able to help. You will need the following to qualify:

- A copy of the eviction notice
- Potential loss of housing due to non-payment of rent and/or other lease violation
- Income must be at or below 50% area median income (AMI)
- Potential loss of housing due to uninhabitable conditions
- Potential loss of housing due to institutional discharge
- Potential loss of housing due to nonpayment of hotel or motel
- Victim of Domestic Violence

Are you literally homeless?

Our **homeless assistance** may be able to help. Below are the requirements for assistance:

- Sleeping in an emergency shelter
- Sleeping in a place not meant for human habitation
- Staying in a hospital or other institution for up to 180 days or was sleeping in an emergency shelter or other place not meant for human habitation immediately prior to entry into the hospital or institution
- Graduating from or timing out of a transitional housing program



If you are **facing eviction** and are **literally homeless**, here is a list of things you will need to apply for HPRP **assistance**:

- Valid S.C. picture ID and Social Security Cards for all household members
- All forms of income verification for last 30 days
- If you do not receive any income, anyone in the household 18 years old or older will need a zero wage statement from the unemployment office.
- Copy of current eviction notice
- Copy of current year lease agreement
- Please bring all receipts of your household expenditures.
